Conditions of Goods Carriage Permit

1. It shall be a condition of every permit that the vehicle or vehicle specified it shall not be used on any public road after the expiry of the permit prescribed in the rule 7 of the Tamilnadu Motor Vehicle Taxation Rules 1974 until such time the tax in respect of such vehicle or vehicles has been paid in accordance with the provisions of the Tamilnadu Motor Vehicle Taxation Act 1974 (Tamilnadu Act of 1974) and the rules and notification issued there under.

2. It shall be a condition of every permit that the vehicle or vehicle or vehicles specified in it shall have a current valid certificate of fitness.

3. It shall be a condition of every permit to use a transport vehicle that there shall not be present to the vehicle even when it is stationary and class of description or goods the conveyance of which contravenes any law or any rule by-law or order made hereunder prohibiting of regulating the import export or transport of such goods or mica for which royalty has not been paid.

4. a). It shall be a condition of every permit of a transport vehicle other than a motor cab that the dates of expiry of the permit and of the certificate of fitness shall be exhibited exteriorly on the left side of the body the cabin in the case of good carriage. Exteriorly on the left side of the body above the position of the rear left wheel and as near the rear entrance as possible in the case of stage carriages in the manner prescribed for weights of the vehicles in rule 93.

b). In the case of a motor cab permitted to ply in the Chennai City, it shall be a condition of every permit that the dates of expiry of the permit and the certificate of fitness shall be exhibited on the exterior of the left half of rear glass bottom most portion above and parallel to the rubber bedding or on the dash board.

5. It shall be a condition of every permit of transport vehicle that the vehicle shall carry a first aid box containing the following articles.

6. It shall be a condition of the permit of every transport vehicle that the vehicle will be so maintained as to be available for the service for which the permit was granted for the entire period of current of the permit and that permit is liable to be suspended or cancelled after the date to which the permit was granted for a continuous period of more than ten days during the period for which the permit authorities the use of the vehicle on the road.

Unless the holder of the permit had obtained in writing the prior permission of the Transport Authority to suspend the service of the vehicle for a specific period exceeding fifteen days.

Provided that no holder of a permit shall ordinarily be granted permission to suspend the service of the vehicle for a condition period exceeding twenty days at a time. Provided further that the period may be extended by such further period as the Transport Authority thinks fit. Provided also that the holder of a permit shall pay the fee prescribed in the table under rule 279.

7. It shall be a condition of every permit of a transport vehicle that the vehicle shall be allowed or caused to be driven only by a duly qualified person holding a valid driving licence.

8. It shall be a condition of every permit of a transport vehicle that the vehicle shall not be allowed or caused to be allowed to carry any stolen property with the acknowledgment that the same was stolen.

9. It shall be a condition of the permit that where a temporary permit under section 7 or a special permit under sub section (8) section 88 is issued to a vehicle covered by the permit the breach of any of the condition of the temporary permit or as the case may be the special permit shall be deemed to be the breach of the conditions of the permit itself and the said permit shall be liable for suspension or cancellation.

10. It shall be condition of permit of every transport vehicle that shall always carry four wooden chokes capable of prevention the motion of the vehicle when kept stationary on public road. The wooden chokes shall be used when the vehicle is kept stationary and shall be taken back when the vehicle resumes its Journey.

11. It shall be a condition of every permit to is a goods carriage that the vehicle shall not be used for the conveyance of any class or description of contravention of any law or any rules by law of order made there under prohibiting or regulation the Import, export or transport of such goods or for the conveyance of mica In respect of which royalty has not been paid.

12. It shall be a condition of every permit to use a goods carriage, that vehicle shall be stopped at a check post or chowkpost whenever any clerks. Traffic Guard chowkidar or at tender employed In such post calls upon the driver of vehicle to stop the vehicle and to keep it at rest for such time as may be necessary to enable him to make a reasonable examination of the contents of the vehicle.

13. It shall be a condition of every permit of goods carriage that unless otherwise in permitted writing be the competent authority prescribed In the rules, the vehicle shall not be loaded in a manner likely to cause danger to any person or in such a manner that the load or any part thereof or anything extends.

- i) Laterally beyond the side of the body or beyond a vertical place in prolongation of the side of body.
- ii) To the front beyond the foremost part of the vehicle.
- iii) To the rear beyond the rear-most part of the vehicle excluding and luggage carrier, and
- iv) In height by a distance which exceeds 380 centimeters from the surface upon with the vehicle rests.

14. It shall be a condition of a permit of every goods carriage that it shall always carry two black and white painted cones with a height of one meter and the base with a diameter of 40 centimeters with road reflector having good reflectivity at the top to be readily available for being placed on the road at the front and at the rear extraeities In the off-side of the goods carriage whenever such vehicle has to be stalled on highways in case of any mechanical failure or breakdowns and accident on the roads where such stalling becomes necessary as a measure of safety warning to the other road users. The two painted cones shall be placed on the ground whenever the vehicle is at rest on the road under the above circumstances and shall be taken back when the vehicle resume its journey.

15. It shall be a conditions of the permit every goods carriages transporting any dangerous or hazardous goods that the goods shall be packed and transported in accordance with the rules 129 to 137 of the Central Motor Vehicle Rules 1989.

16. It shall be a condition of every permit that vehicle to which the permit relates is not driven at a speed exceeding speed permitted under this Act.

17. It shall be a condition of every permit that provisions of this ACT, limiting the hours of work drives are observed In connection with any vehicle or vehicles which the permit relates.

18. It shall be a condition of every permit that the provisions of the chapter 10, 11 & 12 so far as they apply to the holder of the permit are observed.

19. It shall be a condition of every permit that the name & address of the operator shall be printed or otherwise firmly affixed to every vehicle to which the permit relates on the exterior of the body of that vehicle on both side thereof In colour vividly contrasting to the color of the vehicle centered as high as practicable below the window line In bold letters.
